

Character/Vocabulary Practice Format

Stationary: The sheet to use can be downloaded at:

Which characters: You should at least do the characters listed in the vocabulary list as the core vocabulary for the lesson. If you want to do the supplementary ones as well, that is of course encouraged.

Style: You should write in traditional style characters only.

Format: For each character, do the following (as shown in the example):



1. List pinyin (include tones) and English meaning;
2. Count the number of strokes by watching the animated characters PPT online:
www-rohan.sdsu.edu/dept/chinese/materials/101/L1char.ppt
3. List the components, according to the ppt (red and green colored parts).
4. Copy the characters, using the correct stroke order. For information on stroke-order, read page 15 (introduction) of the textbook and watch the animated characters PPT online.
5. Give the character(s) that combine with the head character, based on the textbook.
